# What is Responsive Design

 Responsive web design (RWD) is a web design approach aimed at crafting sites to provide an optimal viewing experience—easy reading and navigation with a minimum of resizing, panning, and scrolling—across a wide range of devices (from desktop computer monitors to mobile phones)



# When to think about Responsive Design

- At the beginning and throughout the project
- Questions to ask:
  - Do you want to provide your content in an easily readable format to your users wherever they are?
  - Do you want to manage your content in one place, or do you want to serve different content to different devices?



# How to design for Responsive Design

- Mobile First
  - Determine what is content that you want to display across all devices and what is just extra that can be on desktop only
  - Determine priority of content based on small screen size



# How to design for Responsive Design

- Create designs for Desktop, Tablet and Mobile Devices
- Use a grid system



- Customize Bootstrap before you download it
  - Customizable content and gutter widths for different size screens
  - Built with LESS.css
  - Many useful built-in components
  - Pick and choose only the components you want to use when building your custom package.


CSS Media Queries

    .page-wrap{ width:730px;}
}
@media (min-width:321px) and (max-width:767px) {
    .page-wrap{ width:90%;}
}
@media (max-width:320px) {
    .page-wrap{ width:100%;}
}
```
